Mitigation/Collection/Disposal Services will commence on a mutually agreed date not later than January 15, 2021, and will continue as necessary until discharge to surface waters and collection of product from Excavation Area are unnecessary.

Restoration Services (if proposed) will be at a date to be determined after collection of product from Excavation Area is complete.

AMENDMENT OF CONTRACT DURATION:
