Do not touch anything in contact with power lines. Carry ladders and other equipment horizontally.



Be aware of all distribution power lines and keep yourself & all equipment at least 10 feet away from lines.



Call KEYS at (305) 295-1010 before starting work near power lines to discuss options about de-energizing power lines.

Protect Yourself

- ✓ Assess your work area for all hazards, including electric lines, at the start of each day.
- ✓ Call KEYS to de-energize power lines if you or your equipment will be too close.
- ✓ Be aware of a distinctive burnt smell.
- ✓ Wear appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).

What You Should Know

- In many instances, KEYS will temporarily disconnect power at no cost.
- Call (305) 295-1010 for questions about de-energizing power lines, if you or your equipment will be close.

- Water and electricity do not mix - be vigilant when working in areas where water is present.
- Trees, tools, and anything else that contacts a line may become energized.
- Stay away from all downed power lines.
